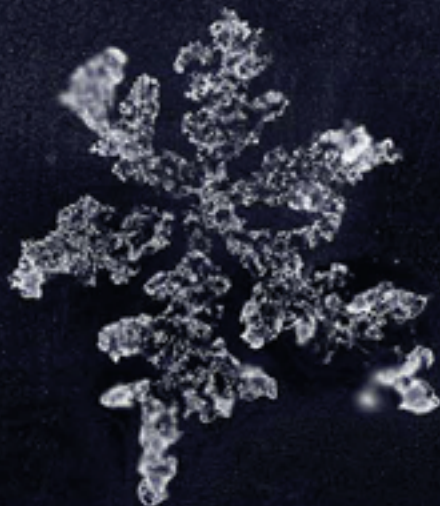


Artistic snow crystal casting during the Antarctic Circumnavigation Expedition
